- 2004: EU membership

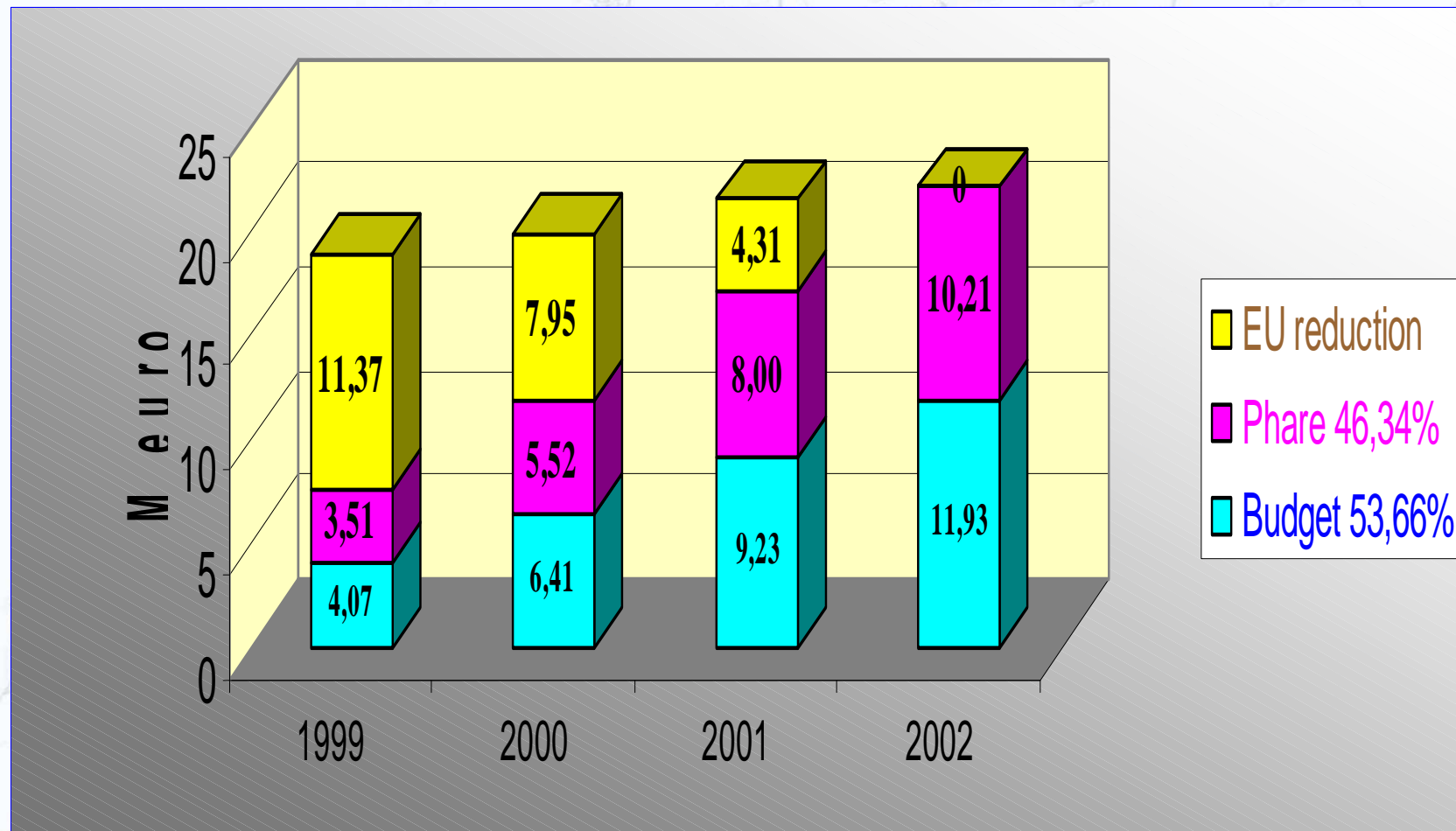
## On R&I policy level

# Challenges

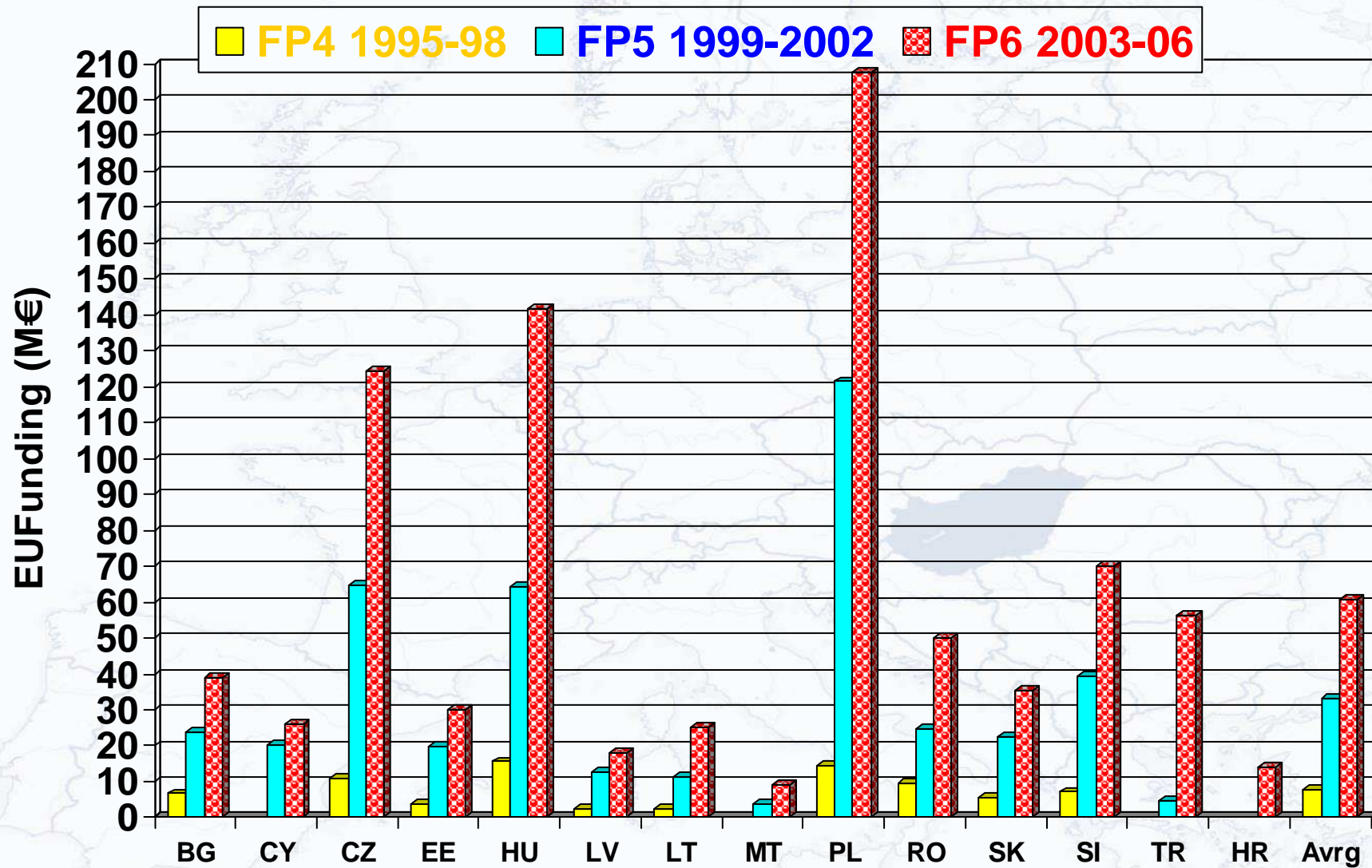
- Freedom versus GERD/GDP

# Hungarian national contribution to the budget of FP5

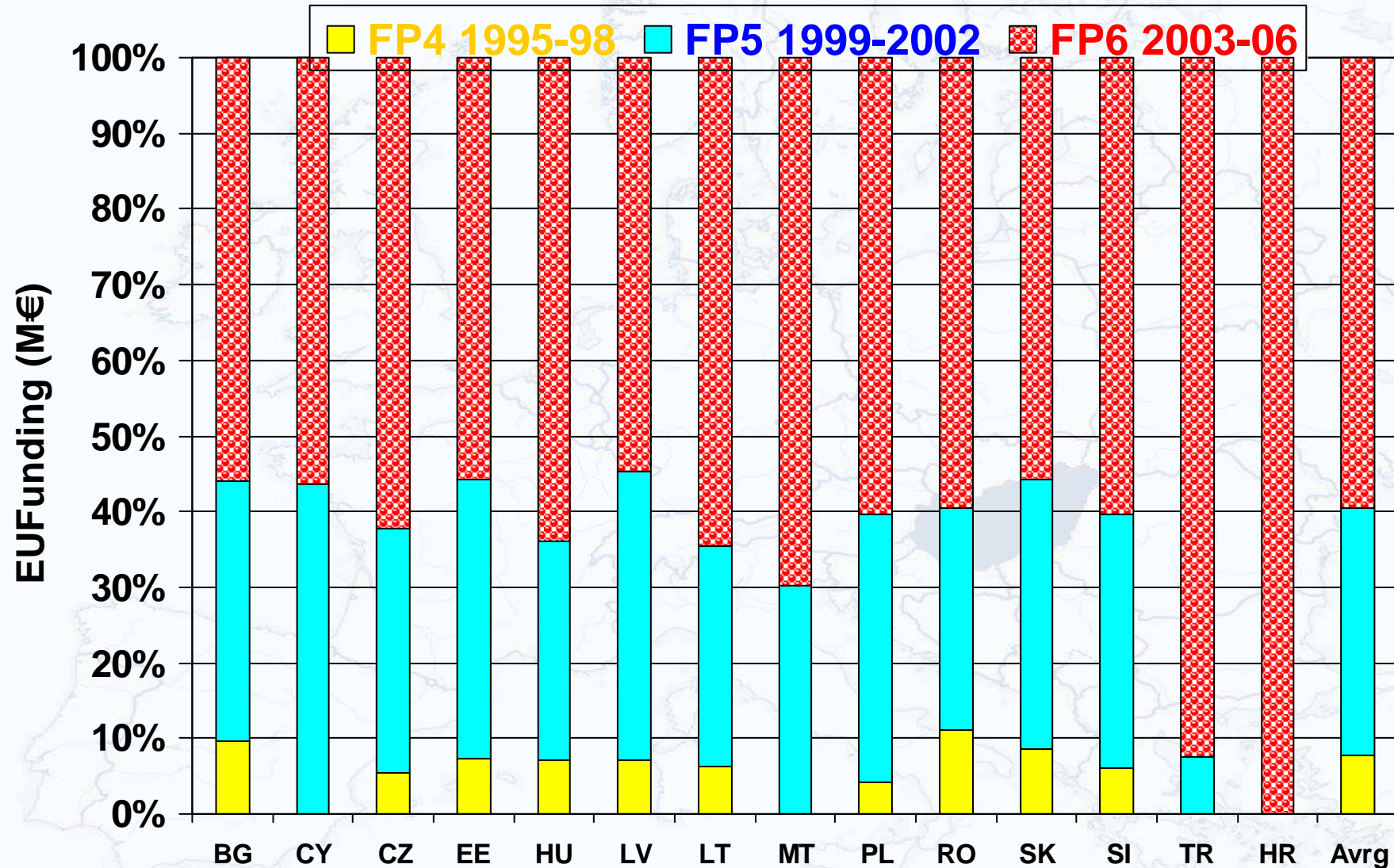




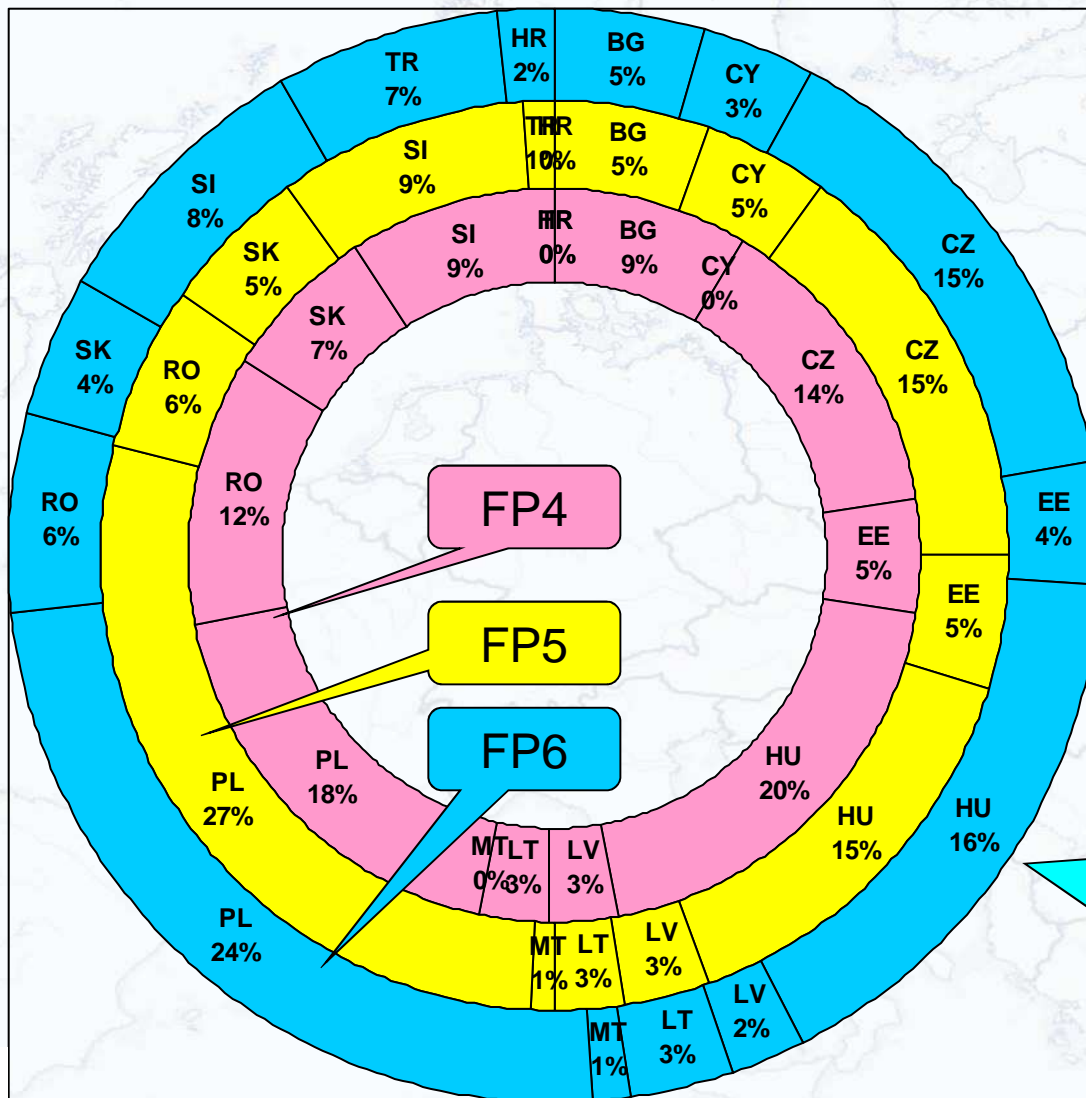
# Resources from FP4/5/6 for ACC/NMS
